



Learn the Colours

Activity duration	2 h
Material needed	Learn the colour box
Number of pupils involved (per box)	1

Step 1: Preparation

Start by asking the pupils what they know about colours. What are the primary colours if they know the secondary colours (subtractive colour system)?

Step 2: Story of the colours tribe

The teacher will begin the activity by telling the story of the colour tribes. When telling the story, the teacher can ask the pupils questions such as "Do you know what colour is created by this mixture?" This keeps the pupils attentive.

Step 3: Creation of the puppets

Now that you know the story of the colour tribes, you can build your puppets in the image of the three tribes.

Each pupil will then create their puppets and experiment with the creation of secondary colours.

When all the pupils have created their puppets, the teacher can read the story again, and the pupils can follow the story with their puppets.



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Step 4: Creation of a colour wheel

To summarise the lesson, the pupils will construct a colour wheel. Simply draw a circle and divide it into 6 equal parts. Paint each part a different colour, as shown in the model below. When the paint is dry, you can write the names of the colours on each part.



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
