HOW TO CREATE YOUR ELEMENTS

STORAGE

The elements necessary for these sequences can be stored in a large envelope or a shoebox.

CRAFT THE ELEMENTS

A. Storytelling resource

1. Print out the annexe SOUND_Storytelling element
2. Cut a plastic straw at 12 cm.
3. Crush the tip of the straw and cut as shown on the dotted lines.
4. Soften the tip with your hands, folding it.
5. Cut out the green rectangle, wrap it around the straw and fix it with glue. For playing, leave 4 cm.
6. Cut out the leaves and glue them to the straw.

SOME NOTES FOR TEACHERS:

- Use a plastic straw because paper does not work! We recommend one made of degradable plastic.
- Cut the plastic straw at a length of 12 cm because if it is shorter, it could be dangerous!



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B. Creating a pan flute

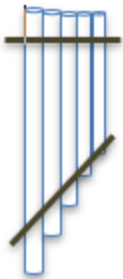
1. Gather the material. You will need a ruler, 5 straws, glue, and cardboard.
2. Take a ruler and measure the straw. The straws should measure 5, 7, 10, 12 and 15 cm (if your original straws are 20cm).
3. Cut out the straw at the desired length.
4. Make sure the straws are perfectly aligned and stick them to a piece of cardboard (the straws should stick out from the cardboard by about 1 cm).



ALTERNATIVES

Create a 100% eco-friendly pan flute.

1. Gather the material. You will need 8 pieces of bamboo of approximately the same diameter, 4 rather thin sticks, and rope.
2. Measure and cut the 8 pieces of bamboo to the following measurements: 18, 16, 14.4, 13.5, 12, 10.8, 9.6 and 9 cm.
3. Line up the 8 pieces of bamboo, place two thin sticks on either side of the bamboo and tie them with rope.
4. Repeat the same operation at the bottom of the flute pan.



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
